EMERGENCY SHELTER:

short-term shelter—Includes Hotel/Motel Voucher Beds

Families with children—397 beds * Single adults—567 beds



TRANSITIONAL HOUSING:

longer-term (up to 24 months) shelter with more intensive services

Families with children—131 beds * Single adults—110 beds

Homelessness (n.): The condition of living in an emergency or transitional shelter or sleeping in a place not meant for human habitation.

Note: This definition does not include staying with family or friends, living in motel, or living in crowded or substandard conditions.
